• Knoxdale is participating in a study through the University of Ottawa and Carleton University on sampling of floors to look for SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19. Swabs will be used to collect samples around the school facility. The goal of this study is to inform public health surveillance strategies for SARS-CoV-2 and any emerging variants of concerns. The primary goal is not to inform school communities whether their environment has COVID-related activity, although that may be one of the long-term benefits of this study. Nor is the intent of this study to replace human testing strategies that have been an important tool in detecting and curbing spread of COVID-19 in schools. Samples will be collected twice weekly and processed monthly. During this period, results will be reviewed by members of the research team.
