Please note that the Extended Day is run separately to the school so if your child is sick, are planning a holiday, or there is a change of contact information, we ask that you contact both the school and EDP separately to advise.

## MEDICATION/LIFE THREATENING CONDITION FORM

Parents of students who either have medications administered at school or have lifethreatening conditions are reminded that forms held by the school expire on the 30 June each year. These forms can be printed off, completed and then need to be passed to your doctor to sign before your child handing them in to our office in September.
